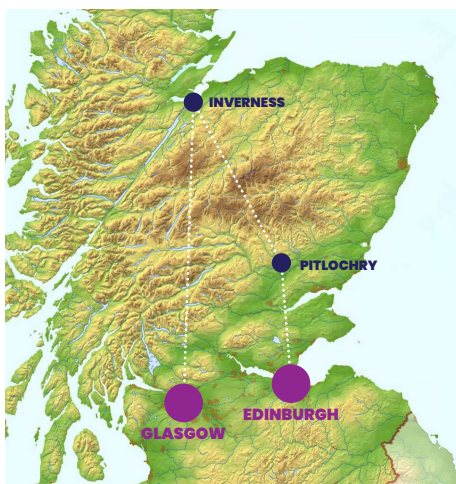

## DAY 2 - GLASGOW HISTORY & STIRLING CASTLE

### MORNING

After a hearty breakfast, you will be navigated on a short City orientation of Glasgow. Learn about the "second City of the British Empire" and its fascinating industrial past.

### AFTERNOON

Travel to Stirling Castle, one of Scotland's greatest stone castles - an icon integral to the nation's diverse history. Generations of Scottish monarchs have enlarged, adapted and embellished Stirling Castle. Afterwards you will visit the National Wallace monument, which commemorates Sir William Wallace, Scotland's National hero. It proudly stands above the fields where William Wallace led his troops to victory and offers impressive views of the surrounding countryside.

## DAY 3 – LOCH LOMOND, GLENCOE & LOCH NESS

### FULL DAY

Journey through the spectacular Loch Lomond and Trossachs National Park with its wooded glens, braes, and lochs. The scenery then takes a dramatic turn as you approach the breathtaking mountains of Glencoe. Famous for the “Glencoe massacre”, learn about the important Jacobite events here which shaped history.

Finish the day with a cruise on mysterious Loch Ness, where you may catch a glimpse of the fabled “Nessie”, one of Scotland’s national treasures.

## DAY 4 – CULLODEN AND EILAN DONAN CASTLE

### MORNING

Visit the Culloden Battlefield, where the course of British, European and world history was changed at Culloden on 16 April 1746. A ferocious war had come to Scotland, dividing families and setting clan against clan.

### AFTERNOON

Travel Westwards towards the iconic Eilan Donan Castle. Situated on an island at the point where three great sea lochs meet, and surrounded by some majestic scenery, it is little wonder that the castle is now one of the most visited and important attractions in Scotland.

## DAY 5 – HIGHLAND COWS AND WHISKY DISTILLERY

### FULL DAY

This morning we travel south through the Cairngorm Mountain range and the Perthshire countryside. We stop in to have a look at the Highland coos along the way then we visit one of the many iconic whisky distilleries in the region to see how the golden liquid is made. On arrival at the hotel, you will have time to relax before either dining at the hotel or taking the short walk into Pitlochry.

## DAY 6 – BRAEMAR & BALMORAL CASTLE

### MORNING

Head Eastwards into the Cairngorm Mountain range through stunning scenery to the Royal town of Braemar. Perfect for some souvenir shopping and a bite to eat.

### AFTERNOON

Heading back towards Pitlochry, we visit Balmoral Castle, the official home of the Royal Family when they are in Scotland. Whilst here you can wander the grounds of this beautiful castle, perhaps spotting one of the King's famous animals, the red squirrel.

## DAY 7 – TRAVEL TO EDINBURGH – TOUR ENDS

### MORNING

Starts 9.30am. After a leisurely breakfast, head southwards towards the capital city of Edinburgh. Marvel at the architecture of the Forth Road and Rail bridges and spot the majestic castle high on its craggy peak as you enter the City. There will be one drop off at Edinburgh airport at 11.30am (if anyone needs dropped here) and then to the Virgin Hotel in central Edinburgh for 12.30.

You can choose to add on a few nights in Edinburgh to see the world famous Military Tattoo, or join one of our Edinburgh Escorted tours for 3 nights / 4 days.
